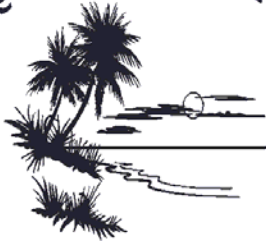

SSI Open Water Diver

During each session you will receive training from the finest professional instructors in central Florida. Your international certification is accredited through SSI (Scuba Schools International) of which the Aquatic Center of Ocala is proud to represent. Your certification will be recognized anywhere in the world as having completed one of the most thorough and comprehensive scuba training programs available.

Entry Level 1 Open Water Scuba Course

Open Water Classes: \$250.00 Per Person. We offer \$75.00 discount off the normal tuition cost with purchase of mask, fins, snorkel, boots, logbook and mouth piece from the Aquatic Center of Ocala this will make the final cost only \$175.00 for the tuition.

Private Classes: \$400.00 per person plus \$75.00 off with purchase of snorkeling system.

Semi Private Classes: \$300.00 per person plus \$75.00 off with purchase of snorkeling system.

Group Classes: \$200.00 per person plus \$50.00 off with purchase of snorkeling system.

All Course Fees Include

1. Scuba Schools International (SSI) Open Water Level One Certification Card.
2. 30-Hour complete comprehensive Scuba Course
3. Classes are held in our modern classroom with comfortable seating
4. Pool sessions are taught in one of our two convenient on-site pools with no pool usage fees.
5. Unlimited pool practice to ensure your safety and comfort at no additional cost
6. If you miss a class for any reason you will be allowed to make up that session with the next class at no additional charge.
7. During training you will train on state of the art equipment. You will have use of the shop air delivery system, buoyancy control system, cylinders, weights and wetsuits for the pool and open water sessions only. This equipment is limited to just the enrolled student. Family members or friends accompanying the student diver at open water can rent equipment at regular rental rates.

Your tuition covers all the above with no hidden fees. Your personal mask, fins, snorkel, boots, logbook and mouth piece will not be included in the course fee. These items will range from \$150.00 to \$300.00 depending on the quality you select and your budget. We would like to have the opportunity to help you try on equipment for proper sizing before investing in it, with the option to exchange an item with no hassle. It is important to learn how to dive with your own properly fitted equipment for maximum enjoyment, comfort and safety. Skills

Open Water Training

After the successful completion of classes, pool training and five (5) open water dives, you will be certified as a level 1 open water diver. The open water dives are completed in one weekend. We at the Aquatic Center schedule training trips on a continual basis. We recommend that you complete your training within 60 days of your last pool session. Students are required to cover the cost of his or her open water certification trip. A variety of trips are offered monthly such as Manatee Springs, Blue Grotto and Paradise Springs. All park entry fees will be your responsibility during training. The entry fees will vary from \$10.00 per day at the state parks to \$30.00 per day at the private parks.

Open Water Referral Letter

Should you end up doing your Open Water Certification Dives in a resort destination without an Aquatic Center Instructor, a **Universal Referral Letter** is included at no charge.

Scuba Skills Update Classes Prior To Certification

If it has been more than 6 months since your last class and pool session, you will need a scuba skills update course to complete your open water certification. **You must make a reservation and reserve a space.** Scuba Skills update is available at \$69.99 for the book and video and for an instructor.

Equipment

I understand that I should not purchase any equipment until meeting with a staff member of the Aquatic Center of Ocala for an Equipment Orientation. You will be given information that will help you make and informed decision on what is best for you. All floatation and air delivery equipment used in the pool and open water sessions of your training must have the AIR & BCP sleeves properly affixed & displayed for your safety. Equipment with out these sleeves will not be allowed in the water until the Aquatic Center technician can inspect it and assure it is working properly. See service rates on our website.

Experience

It is highly recommended that you continue your education and experience after becoming certified. The SSI Specialty courses introduce you to a wider variety of diving activities. Advanced diver, Navigation, Nitrox and Stress and Rescue are just a few to choose from. Information will be provided to you upon request.
